The board of directors (the "Board") of Shanghai Jin Jiang International Hotels (Group) Company Limited (the "Company") is pleased to announce that the following resolutions were passed at the annual general meeting (the "AGM") of the Company held at 9:00 a.m. on Friday, 18 June 2010 at Jin Jiang Grand Hall, Jin Jiang Hotel, 59 Maoming Road (South), Shanghai, the People's Republic of China (the "PRC"). Shareholders or their proxies holding an aggregate of 3,320,968,473 shares with voting rights in the Company, representing 72.748488% of the total number of issued shares of the Company as at the date of the AGM, attended the AGM.

As at the date of the AGM, the number of issued shares of the Company was 4,565,000,000 shares, which was the total number of shares entitling shareholders to attend and vote for or against all the resolutions proposed at the AGM. There was no restriction on any shareholder casting votes on any of the proposed resolutions at the AGM. No shareholder was required to vote only against any of the proposed resolutions at the AGM.

The AGM was chaired by Mr. Yu Minliang, the Chairman and an executive director of the Company. After due consideration, the following resolutions were passed at the AGM by way of poll by shareholders and their proxies, details of which are as follows:

As more than half of the votes were cast in favour of each of Resolutions 1 to 6 and more than two-thirds in favour of Resolution 7, all Resolutions were duly passed as ordinary resolutions and special resolution, respectively.

In accordance with the Rules Governing the Listing of Securities on The Stock Exchange of Hong Kong Limited (the "Listing Rules"), Computershare Hong Kong Investor Services Limited, the H share registrar of the Company, was appointed as the scrutineer at the AGM.

FURTHER INFORMATION ON THE PAYMENT OF THE 2009 FINAL DIVIDEND

The proposed final dividend of RMB2.0 cents per share (inclusive of tax) for the year ended 31 December 2009 has been approved by the shareholders of the Company at the AGM. Shareholders of the Company whose names appear in the register of members of the Company on Thursday, 17 June 2010 are entitled to the said final dividend.

The final dividend payable to holders of H Shares of the Company shall be converted to and paid in Hong Kong dollars based on the average of the closing benchmark exchange rates of Hong Kong dollars against Renminbi announced by the People's Bank of China for the week preceding 18 June 2010, namely HK\$1.00 to RMB0.87557. Based on the above exchange rate, the amount of final dividend payable of HK\$0.02284 per H Share is expected to be paid to holders of H Shares of the Company on or before 17 August 2010.

Pursuant to the Corporate Income Tax Law of PRC and its implementing regulations (hereinafter collectively referred to as the "CIT Law") which took effect on 1 January 2008 and the Notice on Issues relating to the Recognition of Overseas Registered PRC-invested Enterprises as Resident Enterprises based on Actual Management Organisation Standards issued by the State Administration of Taxation on 22 April 2009, the tax rate of the corporate income tax applicable to the income of non-resident enterprise deriving from PRC is 10%. For this purpose, any H shares registered under the name of non-individual enterprise, including the H shares registered under the name of HKSCC Nominees Limited, other nominees or trustees such as securities firms and banks, etc, or other organizations and entities, shall be deemed as shares held by non-resident enterprise shareholders (as defined under the CIT Law). The Company will distribute the final dividend to non-resident enterprise shareholders subject to a deduction of 10% corporate income tax withheld and paid by the Company on their behalf. The Company will not take any responsibility nor accept any claims arising from any delay in, or inaccurate determination of the status of the shareholders or any disputes over the mechanism of withholding.
